Angela Leigh Davis, of New Orleans, Louisiana, passed away May 6, 2015, in Columbiana, Alabama. Angela was born August 8, 1968, in Tallahassee, Florida. She was preceded in death by her father, Thomas Ronald Davis, and by her grandparents James and Rosa Barlow and T.V. and Gladys Davis. She is survived by her mother Betty Barlow Davis of Columbiana; sister Karen Davis of Chelsea; aunts Mary Barlow Horton of Montevallo and Alice Barlow Kitchings (William) of Hoover; uncle Steven Brent Davis (Diane) of Hoover; niece and nephew Rebecca and Bryant Ray of Chelsea; dearest friend Roxana Bianchi Alzamora of Miraflores, Peru; and numerous beloved cousins and friends.

After graduating from Berry High School in Hoover, Angela earned a bachelor's degree in social work from the University of Alabama in Birmingham and a master of social work degree from Tulane University. For more than twenty years, she served as a strong, caring, and compassionate advocate for some of the most vulnerable populations of society including the elderly, victims of AIDS, and the mentally ill.

Angela's passion and creativity found their expression most clearly through the media of music, photography, and poetry. She was a talented and prolific writer whose work has been published in numerous literary journals and anthologies.
