I am very sadden that God called both of them home so close together but her had a reason for that, he must have known he would be so lonesome without her.



I have been knowing him since I was about 4 years old and I shall never forget him and all his family, I fell into our fireplace at the age between 4-5 years old and burned my hands really bad (about a 3rd degree burn) and when I got my hands well he taught me how to write with my right hand because I was left handed before the burn. Also on Saturday night Billy Wayne & some of his brothers and friends used to come to the house to watch wrestling and we would make fudge in an iron skillet, roast peanuts and pop popcorn on an old time wooden stove. We were the poorest family in the neighborhood but the only one with a black & white 13 inch TV to watch so you can imagine what a house full we had but a wonderful time we had for entertainment back then around 1956-1958 when we moved off to Vandiver, Al. Then he walked all the way from Vincent to Vandiver to see us and spent the night and my family & all us kids carried him home the next day. My Mom taught him how to drive also, she was like one of us kids and she loved everyone of those kids like they were her own. When we visited you all when your Mom passed away he asked us if we still made fudge in an iron skillet and we told him yes that is the only way to make it. We had planned to come and see him and bring him some fudge but God wanted him in Heaven to be an Angel so when we get up there we will look him up and see if we can make some up there. All of our prayers are with you at this time and we understand what you are having to face, we lost our Mama in 1974 at the age of 40 year old and I was the oldest of 23 years old and we had a baby brother that was 12 years old at the time, then we lost our Daddy in 1997 but her was a lots old then as well as we were too.
