Clement Ernest Muck, Jr, 85, of Calera, Alabama, passed away January 20, 2023.

Clem was born to Clement Earnest Muck and Wava Ellen Ferris, May 8, 1937, in Portland, Oregon. He graduated from Jefferson High School in 1954. He married Gretchen Rettlesdorf in 1958. They were later divorced. He married Alice Ahlstrom in 1964 and they lived together in several cities throughout the United States. Together they raised three children.

He leaves as his legacy three children: James “Ernie” Erickson (Terri), Susan E. Muck (Patty), Monica Lee Duvall (Douglas D.). He also leaves to cherish his memory seven grandchildren, and one brother, David C. Muck. He was going to be a great-grandfather this coming April. He had three nieces and one nephew. His family remembers him as a charitable man of service. He was preceded in death by his father and mother.

Clem was involved in sales and marketing with several companies during his career and was passionate about affecting the most positive change in people. He founded the McKenzie River Lions Club for numerous benefits in the community of the McKenzie River in Oregon. He owned and operated his own internet business, CTR Bikes, for the benefit of our Latter-day Saint Missionaries throughout the U.S. He also served as a counselor in the

Birmingham Alabama Mission under President Stanford Sainsbury. Clem received the Lifetime Achievement Award for his volunteer work in the community.

A funeral and celebration of Clem's life is scheduled for Wednesday, January 25, 2023. Visitation will be from 9:30 am to 10:30 am at The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, 190 Egg and Butter Road, Columbiana, Alabama. A light luncheon buffet will follow at the church.
