Walton, Donald Roland, age 66, of Alabaster, went to spend eternity with the Lord on November 19, 2016. The visitation will be held from 10:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m., Tuesday, November 22, 2016 at Elkdale Baptist Church in Selma. The memorial service will follow at 11:00 a.m. at the church.

Donny was born on April 6, 1950 in Springfield, Missouri to parents Roland Jasper and Harriet Walton. He grew up in Linden, Alabama, where he was very active in high school sports. He attended Marion Military Institute and Livingston University. He married Diane Green Walton in 1972 and moved to Selma where they lived until 2010 when they moved to Alabaster, Alabama.
