



Jadie Wendell Shaw

February 8, 1922 - November 23, 2010

Funeral services for the late Jadie Wendell Shaw, 88, will be Saturday, November 27, 2010 at 2 PM at Union United Methodist Church. Burial with Military honors will be held at the church cemetery. Visitation will be at Bolton Funeral Home in Columbiana from 6 to 8 PM, Friday, November 26, 2010. He was born to Lewis and Velma Shaw on February 8, 1922 in Shelby County. Mr. Shaw died Tuesday, November 23, 2010 at his residence. Mr. Shaw is preceded in death by his parents, Lewis and Velma Shaw, his wife, Louise Adams Shaw, whom he was married for 64 years and his oldest brother, Lane Shaw. Mr. Shaw entered Army service on October 16, 1943 and stationed with the Company G 5th Inf APO 2 overseas in France. He was wounded in Germany in 1944. He was honorable discharged in 1945 due to his injury from World War II. He received the EAME ribbon with 2 bronze stars, good conduct medal and Purple Heart Medal. Mr. Shaw is a member of Union United Methodist Church (now Union The Church at Chelsea Park) all his life. He joined his brothers in a group first called "Legionnaires" in 1946 and then renamed "Key Master Quartet" in 1952 singing God's gospel songs. They traveled throughout the country singing God's gospel songs for 64 years. Mr. Shaw is survived by his brothers, Bill Shaw, Hubert Shaw; sons, Jerry Wendell Shaw of Talladega and his wife, Cynthia, Johnny Michael Shaw of Wilsonville and his wife, Linda; 6 grandchildren, Dale Shaw, Kevin Shaw, Lora Cooper, Jerry Shaw, Jr., Matt Shaw, Sunni Glenn; great grandchildren, Jessica, Jeremy, Emma, Grey, Kyler, Mathew, Bella, Emily, Tyler; great great
