Dr. James Glasgow Alston Sr. DMD, age 75, died September 10, 2010 at a local hospital. Dr. Alston was born January 25, 1935 in Sylacauga, Alabama. He graduated from Shades Valley High School in Birmingham. He attended Auburn University and received his B.S degree from Birmingham Southern College. He was awarded a Doctorate of Medical Dentistry from the University of Alabama School of Dentistry in 1960. Dr. Alston practiced dentistry for over 45 years, the majority of that time in Columbiana, Alabama. Dr. Alston was a member of many professional and civic organizations. He will be sorely missed by his family, friends, and colleagues. He is survived by his wife of twenty one years, Sandra C. Alston; his son, James G.
