Mary Ruth Mann Trimble, born November 8, 1946, in Winston County, Alabama, passed away on August 30, 2023, after a long battle with a neurological disease.

A celebration of Mary's life will be held at 2:00pm on Tuesday, September 5, 2023, at Bolton Funeral Home in Columbiana, AL. Visitation with the family will be from 1:00pm until 2:00pm. Interment will follow at Prospect Baptist Church Cemetery, Highway 51, Wilsonville, AL.

Mary was preceded in death by her parents: Rufus and Stacil Mann; sister: Nellie Sue Mann; brother: Rufus Mann, Jr.; and grandson: Trooper Huggins.

She is survived by her husband of 57 years and primary caretaker: Travis R. Trimble, Jr.; three children: Jamie (Kim), Daniel (Dana), and Stacy (Michael); eight grandchildren; brother: Bennis Mann; sister: Mattie Heatherly; and numerous nieces and nephews.

Before becoming physically unable, Mary worked with the Shelby County Baptist Association Community Ministries Thrift Shop,

collecting donations and helping those in the community in need.

Mary was known for her warm smile and always giving to others, especially when it came to food. As an amazing cook, she would frequently bake for friends and family. While her children were in school, she kept the school office regularly supplied with baked goods, particularly her cinnamon rolls.

Throughout her adult life, Mary lived and struggled with the neurological disease neurofibromatosis (NF).
