Ronnie Lawson Hunt, age 74, of Columbiana, AL, passed away on Tuesday, May 25, 2022, at his residence. He was born in Cedartown, GA, in 1947, son of the late Robert and Burnell Hunt of Tallapoosa, GA. He is also preceded in death by his granddaughter, Rebecca Hunt, also of Columbiana.

He had a wonderful sense of humor and loved to make others laugh by telling jokes or pulling pranks! In later years Ronnie enjoyed traveling and spending time outdoors. He backpacked with family members from the south rim to the north rim of the Grand Canyon. He loved the ocean and the beach, making many trips to Florida and to St. John, USVI. He also traveled to New York,

Colorado, and many other states in the Southwest.

Ronnie was a born again Christian and a longtime member of First Baptist Church of Columbiana. A Memorial Service to celebrate his life will be held Sunday, May 29, 2022, at 2:00 pm in the Chapel of Bolton Funeral Home in Columbiana, AL, with Dr. Mike Miller officiating. His ashes will be buried in Pinelawn Gardens Cemetery at a later date.
