Winkle, Sabra Phillips, age 58, of Vestavia Hills, AL, passed away on January 10, 2021. A private funeral service will be at 1:00 p.m., Thursday, January 14, 2021 at Vestavia Hills United Methodist Church. A private burial service will follow at 2:30 p.m. at Pinelawn Gardens Cemetery in Columbiana, AL.

She was born on January 4th, 1963 in New Orleans, LA and grew up in Columbiana, AL where she graduated from Shelby County High School in 1981. Sabra attended Auburn University and graduated in 1985. It was there that she met her husband, Jeff Winkle. They were married later that same year. Sabra and her husband lived in Atlanta, Champaign, IL, Chicago, and Cincinnati before returning back home to Alabama in 1996. Sabra was active in many activities involving her children, including the PTA. She also worked as a teaching assistant in a local elementary school.
