



## Samuel Lee Barnes

August 2, 1941 - September 9, 2014

Samuel "Lee" Barnes, 73 of Williamsville, IL, died at 12:13 p.m. on Tuesday, September 9, 2014 at St. John's Hospital in Springfield, IL.

Lee was born August 2, 1941 in Shelby County, AL, the son of Jesse Windsor and Mamie Jane White Barnes. He married Charlotte McCain on April 1, 1963 in Talladega, AL.

Lee graduated from Shelby County High School in 1959 and then earned his Bachelor's degree in Mathematics in 1963 from Jacksonville State University in Jacksonville, AL. He worked his entire career in the insurance industry, most recently as a vice president at Horace Mann until his retirement. He served on the Williamsville School Board for 8 years, the village board for 11 years, and as mayor in the late 90's and early 2000's. Lee enjoyed fishing and spending time with family and friends. He was also active in his church, serving as treasurer, deacon, elder, trustee, and youth sponsor.

He was preceded in death by his parents and five brothers.
